JESUS gave gifts for equipping the saints for ministry

- **Apostles** connect **cultures** to Yahweh's Kingdom
- **Prophets** connect people to the **purposes** of God & His Kingdom
- **Evangelist** connect people to the **news** of God & His Kingdom
- **Pastors** connect people to the **nourishment** of God's **Word**
- **Teachers** connect people to the **wisdom** of God

Apostle (Grk. *apostollos*): sent, an official delegate / ambassador sent to an appointed place on a government mission.



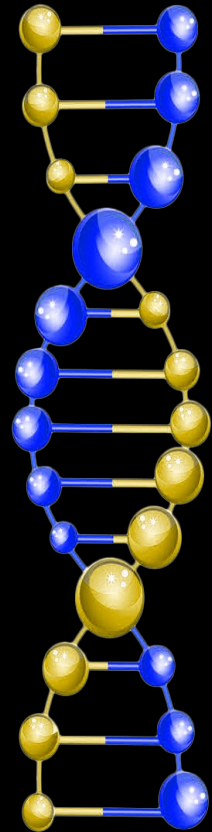
- A Greek term used by the ancient Roman government for officials who were sent to conquered territories for the purpose of establishing the culture of Rome as a colony of Rome.

Culture: customs, arts & social institutions, religion, language of a people group that collectively reflect a governing influence or order.

Culture reflects the **IDENTITY** of a people group.

An apostle *connects* a people to a new identity under a new government.

The first Apostle was Adam – created in God's image to steward the generations of earth in connection to God's government.



Gen. 1:1 *In the beginning, God created the heavens **AND** the earth.*

- **And** (Heb. et) Aleph-Tav – **אֵת** contracted from **אֶת**, (Aleph – Vav – Tav): to connect

Gen. 2:1, 4 *“Thus the heavens **and** the earth were finished, and all the host of them These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens.*

Gen. 1:27 *So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He **him**; male and female created He them.*

- Him (Heb. et): Aleph-Tav – **אֵת** (also contracted from **אֶת**)
- Them (Heb. et): plural - **אֹתָם**



Empire Building

Deut. 32:8 *“When the Most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when He separated the sons of Adam, He set the bounds of the people according to the number of the **sons of God.**”*





HOWEVER!

Deut. 32:9 – “For the **Lord's portion is His people,** Jacob His allotted inheritance.”

Exo. 20:3 – “You shall have no other gods before Me.”

Israel was to be a light to the nations.

They were the firstfruits of a people delivered and bringing a territory back to God.

God's first Ekklesia

Mission to Claim Inheritance
Connecting Heaven's Throne & Earth

Joshua led Israel (prince of God)

They follow The Captain of the Lord's

Acts 7:38 *"This is the one [Moses] who

Building Empires vs. Claiming Inheritance

The Great Apostle Yeshua is still on an inheritance mission!

Ps. 2:7-8 *“I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. Ask of Me, and I will give You **the nations for Your inheritance**, and the ends of the earth for Your possession.”*

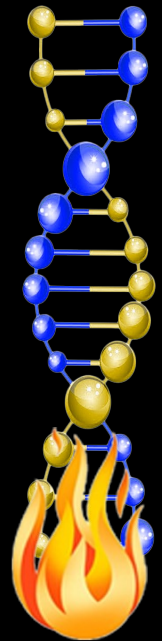
Isaiah 9:6 – *“Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over his kingdom, to order and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts [armies] will perform this.” (NKJV)*

- **Zeal** (Heb. *qina*) – great intensity of feeling, passion, jealousy; ***the final activity of the first***.



As Yeshua's body, we have His Apostolic DNA

- **Heb. 3:1** *“Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession – Jesus.”*
- **Isa. 42:6-7** *“I am the Lord, I have called You in righteousness, I will also hold You by the hand and watch over You, And I will appoint You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the nations, ⁷ To open blind eyes, To bring out prisoners from the dungeon and those who dwell in darkness from the prison.”*



John 6:28-29

*“Therefore they said to Him, ‘What are we to do, so that we may accomplish the works of God?’²⁹ Jesus answered and said to them, ‘This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has **sent**.’”*

John 20:21 *“So Jesus said to them again, ‘Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.’”*

Luke 10:19 *“I give you authority...”*
