1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
2. Before reading 10:25-37, skim through what Jesus says in the first half of chapter 10. Who does Jesus say God has revealed things to and who has God not revealed these things to?

**Read Luke 10:25-37**

3. As the expert of the law answers Jesus, how should we think about him in light of how you answered question 2?
4. Based on the conversation before the parable begins in verse 30, what do you think is the expert's primary concern in the conversation with Jesus?
5. What do we know about the man who is attacked by robbers?
6. The priest and Levite are both leaving Jerusalem. Why is this important to the parable? (hint, what is the purpose of the temple in the Old Testament?)
7. What do you know about Samaritans compared to Jewish people? Why does Jesus choose a Samaritan for this story?
8. How does the Samaritan care for the man? What are all the specific things he does?
9. How does Jesus change the expert's original question at the end of the parable?
10. If our purpose is to love God, what can we do based on this passage to show our love of God? Be specific!
11. If our purpose is to love each other, what can we do based on this passage to show our love for each other?
12. How can we follow the example of the Samaritan in such a way that it challenges others to go and do likewise?
