THREE MINDSETS ABOUT GENEROSITY

1) THE BAG: THERE IS NEVER ENOUGH.

... You eat, but do not have enough; You drink, but you are not filled with drink; You clothe yourselves, but no one is warm; And he who earns wages, earns wages to put into a bag with holes. Haggai 1:6 NKJV

2) THE BASKET: THERE IS ENOUGH.

All these blessings will come on you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God ... ⁵Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed. Deuteronomy 28:2, 5
