PREPARING THE PREACHER

(Exodus 2:1-25)

God's people may be in difficult circumstances, but God has a plan. But God will be faithful to His promise to do a mighty work through His people. What has God prepared you for?

I. MOSES WAS BEING PREPARED IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (vv. 1-12)

- 1. This is a beautiful picture of faith and love.
 - These un-named heroes exercised great faith in practicing the God given blessings of marital relations.
 - o She hid him three months knowing he could be killed
 - o She put him in the river as commanded by Egyptian law but by faith built the basket.
 - o God put together two things he made: a babies cry and a woman's heart.
- 2. Moses is educated by his Mama
 - Moses spends his most formative developmental years under the teaching of his mother.
 - He is going to learn about the Lord, the covenant God made with Israel.
- 3. Moses is educated by the best schools in Egypt.
 - We see God's hand on Moses as he protected Him.
 - We see God's hand on Moses as he prepared Him

II. MOSES WAS BEING PREPARED IN HIGH SCHOOL (vv. 11-14)

- 1. There is a long time between verse 10-11. Moses grew up.
- 2. For forty years Moses lived in Pharaoh's court, but he couldn't deny who he was.
 - Moses "grew up" that caused him to see things for what they were.
 - 3. Moses witnessed the brutal assault of one of his own Israelite people.
 - His sense of justice was right, but his impetuosity was wrong.
 - 4. Notice that the Egyptians weren't his only problem; the Hebrews were going to be trouble.
 - 5. Some lessons of God in life are learned the hard way.
 - We look around but when we need to look up.
 - In our haste, we act on our plans instead of God's.

III. MOSES WAS BEING PREPARED IN COLLEGE (vv.15-22)

- 1. Moses fled Egypt to the land of Midian.
 - The Midianites were from the fourth son of Abraham by Keturah.
 - Moses combats injustice only this time he doesn't kill anyone.
 - Then he shows servant leadership by watering the woman's flock.
- 2. His father-in-law was a priest of the Most High God.
 - His father-in-law was a great mentor for him.
- 3. Worked with sheep for forty more years.
 - God says we are like sheep.

God often takes time to equip his servants for His work. The best learning sometimes comes in the most surprising times and places. Sometimes it comes with the hands-on experience. But it always comes when we look to the Lord. What is God preparing you for?
